ATHLETIC GUIDELINES

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Gates open at 5:30 P.M. for varsity football games and one hour before middle school football games and all other MPSD Athletic Events
- Implementation of walk-through metal detectors at MPSD Sporting events
- No re-entry upon exit
- No book bags will be allowed. Purses, camera bags, and diaper bags are permitted
- No loitering
- All K-8th grade students must be supervised by a parent or guardian while attending Meridian Public School District athletic events during the 2021-2022 school year
- Any K-8th grade student without a parent or guardian will not be admitted to MPSD athletic events
- Students in grades 9-12 must present an MPSD student ID or valid photo ID before entering the game
- If a fan is asked to leave an event, due to misconduct, he or she will not be allowed to attend another sporting event

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- All spectators must wear a face covering (over the nose and mouth) when entering and exiting the stadium. Spectators must also wear a face-covering when they are unable to maintain the recommended physical distance from others who are not in the same household
- Spectators must adhere to social signage while attending MPSD athletic events
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the stadium along with increased signage to encourage social distancing
- Only MPSD staff members and other authorized personnel will be allowed on the field

TAILGATING

Tailgating for MHS home football games will be prohibited with the exception of the Homecoming game. Details regarding the Homecoming game will be announced soon. This includes all tailgating, picnics, fanfare areas, etc...
